I would assume that over the course of the last twelve months many of us have felt exhaustion and monotony. There are days where I have felt like I was trudging through deep mud, like I wasn't making the progress I had planned for myself and my work. But by God's grace there are so many passages where He encourages us to not lose heart, to not grow weary in doing good and to keep serving others (Gal. 6:9; 2 Thess. 3:13). As I start 2021 and once again begin filling up the calendar, I will trust in God's goodness and sovereignty and remember that everything I'm trying to do in service to him is by his mercy and he measures success by my faithfulness to him.

1. Evangelism

Here are some of the local studies taking place:

- **Local Evangelism:** Since I last wrote, I am excited to share that I was finally able to hold a gospel meeting in December! It was the first meeting I have held since the pandemic began last March. The Warfield Blvd. congregation in Clarksville, TN invited me to hold a weekend meeting on, “The Life of Christ” (you can find the audio for this series here bit.ly/3pL3vuT). In February I have been invited to preach several times.

- **Teen Studies:** Our teen studies in Daniel and Romans have continued through the school year. In January we covered Daniel 7 & 8 and made it through Romans 4. Lord willing, we will conclude Daniel sometime in March. We will have to discuss if we want to pick up the pace of Romans to conclude it before the end of the school year, or if we want to maintain our current speed and make it our goal to cover it through 2021.
- **2021 Bible Camp Preparations:** Over the weekend of January 14-16, the staff of SALT and LIGHT Bible camps met to work on our plans for 2021. Our theme for this year will be, "It Is Well With My Soul". We are currently working on updating our web site and getting online registration ready. The date for these camps is June 13th-19th. 2. Edification & Equipping of the Saints (Biblical Counseling)



Studies in Process - The average duration for many of these studies is 8-12 weeks. However, with everything happening in 2020 many of these studies are going longer than normal.

Consultation - Over the last year God has provided more opportunities to help brainstorm with Christians in other places who are seeking advice on how to serve people they are studying with. I usually share Biblical texts, principles and possible resources. Depending on the particular situation these consultations can be as short as a single phone call, or multiple calls & texts per week. I am grateful for the men and women God is using to compassionately minister his word to people in need!

Studies Completed - These are studies that have concluded because the students have matured, grown, overcome whatever it is that brought them our way.
