Studies in process - The average duration for many of these studies is 8-12 weeks.

Studies on the Waiting List - These are people who have requested studies, and are waiting for an opening in the schedule.

Current Consultation – God has provided opportunities to help brainstorm with Christians in other places who are seeking advice on how to counsel. Depending on the situation these consultations can be a single phone call, or weekly calls or texts. I am grateful for the men and women God is using to compassionately minister his word to others!



Counseling Training Class – For nearly 5 months I have been facilitating a weekly, 1-hour class on how to use the Bible to help disciples who are struggling in their daily walk in some way. We have 5-6 people attend the class. Some of the participants live hours away, and they join us via Zoom.


