	The Hebrew writer rebuked his readers, because spiritually they had
	grown deformed. They had aged, yet had not matured or gotten stronger. If a physical child never matured past the need for milk,
	doctors would quickly become concerned! But these folks became content to arrest their spiritual development and even regress. We
	want to make sure we push on to mature in the grace of Christ!
